Need Money for School?

Ask about how you can qualify for Needs-Based Scholarships & Travel Stipends!



Needs-Based Scholarships are available through federal workforce development grants offered through your local *American Job Center*.

The purpose of the grant program is to promote an increase in employment, help people to retain jobs and improve their earnings potential, help you to continue to learn and earn a credential, and to make it easier for you to gain the work skills needed so that you can enter the workforce.

You may qualify for training grants up to \$4000 if you live in the counties of Benton, Carroll, Crockett, Dyer, Gibson, Henry, Lake, Obion, & Weakley.

Here's how it works:

- 1. Complete an admissions application to the school of your choice.
- 2. Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (if available for your institution). https://fafsa.ed.gov/
- 3. Call your local American Job Center (AJC) and make an appointment with a Career Advisor to talk about how you can qualify for a Needs-Based Scholarship to cover your unmet financial need.
- 4. Show up on time for your appointment!
 Bring your drivers license, social security card, income information & all documents requested by the AJC staff.

What does the Needs-Based Scholarship cover?

PLUS - You may be eligible for a travel stipend!!

Federal workforce development grants provide Needs-Based Scholarships to eligible applicants entering into approved training.

Training programs must be certified and placed on a statewide list maintained by the Tennessee Higher Education Commission (THEC).
