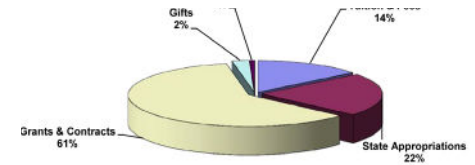

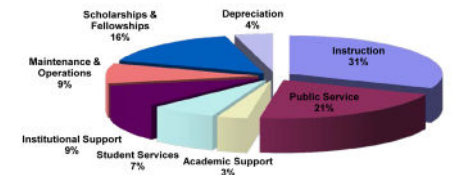


Operating Expenses

For the Year Ended June 30, 2012

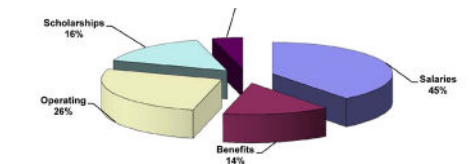

Ground Breaking Innovations

Community leaders, state officials, members of the Tennessee Board of Regents along with members of the Dyersburg State Community College administration, student body, faculty and staff gathered on Wednesday, November 16, 2011, at the DSCC Jimmy Naifeh Center at Tipton County to celebrate the ground breaking for the new Learning Resource Center, Student Center and Tipton County Public Library.

Before the actual ground breaking, State Representative and Speaker Emeritus Jimmy Naifeh, Tennessee Board of Regents Chancellor John Morgan, State Senate Majority Leader Mark Norris, State Representative Minority Leader Craig Fitzhugh, State Senator Roy Herron, Tipton County Executive Jeff Huffman, Covington Mayor David Gordon, DSCC President Karen Bowyer, and DSCC Foundation Board Immediate Past Chair David Hayes each spoke on the history and the importance of the project to the more than 200 gathered in the auditorium in the Academic Building.

“Several of us have dreamed of a new facility which includes the DSCC Learning Resource Center and the Tipton County Public Library at the DSCC Jimmy Naifeh Center at Tipton County. It will provide much needed space for our students. This new space includes computer classrooms and labs; an enhanced student tutoring lab and emporium; study rooms; an activities space with table tennis, pool, Wii exercise programs, and Student Government offices,” said DSCC President Karen Bowyer.

The project is a special collaboration between Tipton County government and DSCC. By sharing library and learning resource center facilities, the college and the community will underscore the importance of lifelong learning.

Celebration

DSCC Gibson County Center Celebrates 20 Years

In celebration of the 20-year anniversary of the opening of its Gibson County Center, Dyersburg State Community College welcomed the community to an early morning reception on Wednesday, February 29, 2012.

On December 19, 1991, Dyersburg State opened the then newly constructed Gibson County facility next to Peabody High School in Trenton. The first classes were held in the center in January 1992.

Since opening its doors 20 years ago, over 6,000 students have attended classes at the DSCC Gibson County Center. More than 900 DSCC graduates have enrolled in one or more courses. Many of these students have commented that they would never have started college if it were not for the Dyersburg State Gibson County Center.

The Center houses six master classrooms, four of which include Sympodium systems; an interactive television classroom; a mathematics lab with 30 computer stations; a computer lab with 20 computer stations; a Learning Resource Center equipped with 14 computers; and a combination science classroom/lab which includes 24 lab stations and four computers. In addition, the Center has a large commons area and a bookstore.

DSCC Jimmy Naifeh Center at Tipton County's 15th Year

What was an open field 15 years ago has today become a growing center for learning for West Tennessee residents. On Friday, March 23, 2012, state and local officials along with representatives from the Tennessee Board of Regents, Dyersburg State Community College students, faculty and staff members gathered together and marked the construction of the facility now known as the DSCC Jimmy Naifeh Center at Tipton County.

State Representative and Speaker Emeritus of the Tennessee Legislature Jimmy Naifeh spoke to the more than 80 gathered at the DSCC JNC for the annual College Donor/Scholarship Recipient luncheon. In his remarks he said, "Helping establish the center here in Covington has been one of my greatest accomplishments as state representative."

Since the extension of DSCC was established in Covington in 1982, more than 10,000 students have taken classes here. "As you can see from our photos, we have come a long way from where we started -- offering classes at night in the high school, and operating from a rented facility," said Dr. Karen Bowyer, DSCC president. "We have come a long way, and with the need for higher education in our area, we still have a long way to go," she stated.
