Changing Lives

DSCC Upward Bound Team Wins Tennessee Scholars' Bowl

Dyersburg State Community College's (DSCC) Upward Bound Team recently brought home a first place win from the Tennessee Association of Special Programs (TASP) Scholars' Bowl competition held in Greeneville, TN on March 9. The team traveled to Atlanta, GA where they competed for the regional Southeastern Association of Educational Opportunity Program Personnel (SAEOPP) title on April 20 against other state-winning teams from Alabama, Georgia, Kentucky, Mississippi, North Carolina and South Carolina. The Kentucky State All-Star team took the regional first place title in Atlanta.

Six teams competed in the Tennessee state competition, including six members of the Dyersburg State Community College (DSCC) Upward Bound team. Team members include high school students Ryane Norville, Amber Alsup, Erica Dunevant, Josh Fowlkes and Cameron Brown, all from Dyer County High School, as well as Summer Johnson from Peabody High School.

The Tennessee Scholars' Bowl competition, consisting of a trivia-style educational quiz bowl, is held annually and welcomes Upward Bound Scholars' Bowl teams from throughout Tennessee. This year marks the 18th year DSCC teams have participated in the state competition. The DSCC Upward Bound team previously won the state competition in 2003 and 2008 as well as 2013; and brought home the SAEOPP regional title in 2003 and second place in 2008.

The DSCC Upward Bound program is a federally funded U.S. Department of Education program and provides support to high school students in their preparation for college entrance. It also provides opportunities for students to achieve success in their precollege performance and higher education pursuits.

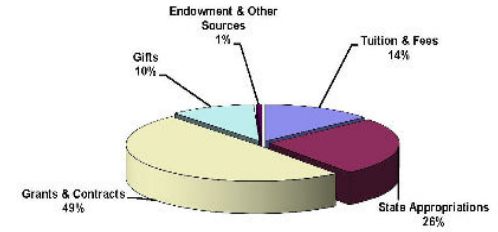

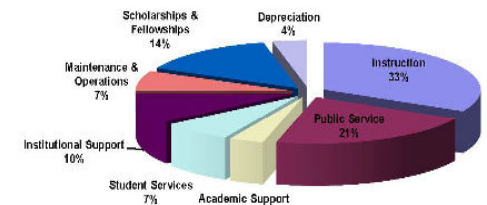


Operating Expenses

For the Year Ended June 30, 2013

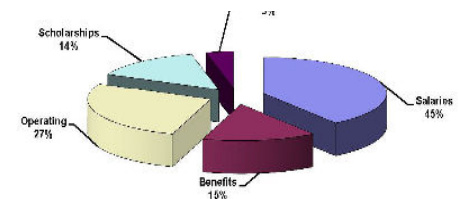

40 Years Service, Three Presidents

On October 12, Dyersburg State Community College President Karen Bowyer presented service awards to 27 members of the DSCC faculty and staff. At this presentation, Beverlee Weatherly, administrative assistant for the President's office, was recognized for her 40 years of service to the College.

Weatherly was hired by DSCC in 1972, three years after the college was founded, as an accounts payable clerk in the Business office. In 1978, she was named secretary to the dean of Administrative Services.

During her 40-year tenure at DSCC, she has worked for all three DSCC presidents. In 1980, she moved to the President's office and served as secretary for Dr. E.B. Eller, DSCC's first president. She continued her work in the President's office as executive secretary to President Carl Christen Andersen from 1981 to 1984. From 1984 to the present she has served as President Karen Bowyer's administrative assistant.

Weatherly, who holds her Associate of Science degree from DSCC, was named Secretary of the Year in 1988. She is past president and secretary of the DSCC Administrative Professionals Council and has served as chair of the Outstanding Employee selection committee. She has been a member of the College's Strategic Planning, Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS) reaffirmation, and 25th, 35th, and 40th Anniversary Celebration committees.

"Working at Dyersburg State has been a great experience. I've learned a lot, seen a lot of changes, and developed lifelong friendships. Working here has been a blessing in my life," Weatherly said.

Accomplishments

A Clean Sweep Hopkins named DSCC Outstanding Alumnus

Cleaning is a chore most people would not welcome. This is not the case with Todd Hopkins, founder and CEO of Office Pride Commercial Cleaning Services, a multi-million dollar janitorial franchising company and co-author of the book *The Janitor*.

Because of his success in his professional and personal life, Hopkins was named an Outstanding Alumnus of Dyersburg State Community College on November 13. The surprise presentation took place during the Tennessee Small Business Development Center's second annual Rising Star Small Business Award Banquet where Hopkins served as guest speaker. More than 80 entrepreneurs and guests attended the event that was held in the Student Center on the Dyersburg Campus.

While Hopkins success in the cleaning industry is widely known, his start on this path is not. A native of Crockett Mills, Hopkins chose to attend Dyersburg State after high school. Ever business savvy, Hopkins said, "Dyersburg State provided the best education value for the money. I was able to live at home and commute." While attending DSCC, Hopkins was a work-study student in the Office of Institutional Advancement and said that this experience "got him off to a good start." He was a member of the Student Government Association and was a Student Ambassador. In 1985, he graduated from DSCC with his Associate of Science in Business and was awarded the Karen A. Bowyer Scholarship to attend what was then known as Memphis State.

Hopkins graduated from Memphis State in 1987, and then took a position as a traveling consultant for his college fraternity. He was based in Indianapolis, Indiana and while living there began work on his Masters of Business Administration at Butler University. Hopkins became interested in the cleaning business in an entrepreneurial class in which he had worked on a project with a woman who owned a janitorial service. He wrote his master's thesis on the franchise janitorial business. Afterwards, Hopkins bought his classmate out and from this start has grown Office Pride, a business with over 100 franchises in 14 states.

Hopkins has since turned the operations for Office Pride over to a company president. His focus is now on writing and speaking, as well as leading seminars and men's retreats. In 2007, Hopkins, along with co-author Ray Hilbert published *The Janitor: How an Unexpected Friendship Transformed a CEO and His Company*. Reviews of the book call it "compelling, heartwarming and life-changing."

When considering all his higher education experiences, Hopkins said, "my best experience was at Dyersburg State. I got to know the faculty and made friendships. I had no problem transferring and I felt well-prepared, especially in math. Dr. Don Holland was awesome."

DSCC Nursing Student Adds Coca-Cola New Century Scholar to Her Long List of Accomplishments

Miranda Davis, Nursing student at Dyersburg State Community College, was recently named as a Coca-Cola New Century Scholar. This program is sponsored by the Coca-Cola Scholars Foundation and the Coca-Cola Foundation, the American Association of Community Colleges and administered by the Phi Theta Kappa (PTK) Honor Society.

Fifty scholars were selected to receive this award based on their scores earned in the All-USA Community College Academic Team competition, for which more than 1,800 applicants applied this year. The recipients chosen are the highest scoring students in each state. Judges considered grades, leadership, activities and how students extend their intellectual talents beyond the classroom.

Miranda will be awarded a \$2,000 scholarship and plaque from the Coca-Cola Scholars Foundation and the Coca-Cola Foundation. She will be recognized at the Annual PTK President's Breakfast held during the upcoming American Association of Community College's Annual Convention in San Francisco, CA.

Miranda, of Covington, is a Nursing student with a 4.0 GPA at the DSCC Jimmy Naifeh Center at Tipton County. Upon graduation this May, she plans to continue her education by obtaining her master's degree in Nursing from Vanderbilt University. She holds PTK leadership positions and was recently chosen as a member of the PTK All-Tennessee Academic Team. Miranda also recently received the prestigious PTK Guistwhite Scholarship where she was awarded a medallion and a \$5,000 scholarship for baccalaureate studies. She is the first Guistwhite Scholar recipient in DSCC's history.

DSCC Student Honored to Serve

Kicell Stokes, a criminal justice student at Dyersburg State Community College was selected to assist in the 57th Presidential Inauguration Parade and Ceremonies in Washington D.C. from January 16-25, 2013 with his 268th Military Police Company of the Tennessee Army National Guard in Ripley, Tennessee.
