# **Veteran Checklist**

Complete the following checklist if you are an active-duty, honorably discharged or retired (up to 15 years post-retirement) member of a Uniformed Service (Marine Corps, Navy, Army, Air Force, Coast Guard, Space Force or National Guard) and intend on applying to Dyersburg State Community College (DSCC).

## **DSCC Application Process**

- Create a Login ID and PIN, and fill out the free online application.
- Send an official copy of all high school and college transcripts, including military/Joint Service (JST) transcripts, to DSCC.
  - Visit JST to order military transcripts.
- Submit an official ACT/SAT score if you are under 21 years of age. If you do not have either/or, sign up to take the <u>ACCUPLACER</u> test.
- Provide a completed <u>Immunization Health History</u> form.

#### **Financial Aid Process**

- Complete the <u>FAFSA</u>. The FAFSA must be filled out **ANNUALLY** in order to receive financial aid.

## **VA Benefits Process**

- Create or log in to your <u>benefits account</u>.
- Request your Certificate of Eligibility (COE).
- Request your Report of Separation (DD214-Member4) or Notice of Basic Eligibility (DD Form 2384).
- TO TRANSFER BENEFITS TO A SPOUSE OR DEPENDENTS
  - Visit the <u>Department of Defense Transferability of Education Benefits</u> (TEB).
    - Choose "edit" for any family member listed who you wish to transfer your benefits.
    - Choose the start/end dates AND the estimated number of months benefits will be used.
    - Indicate you understand your actions and submit.
  - Visit TEB to track the status of your transfer request. The date and status will appear in the upper left corner after approval.

# **Using Benefits at DSCC**

- Submit your COE. THIS IS A REQUIREMENT FOR CERTIFICATION.
  - o Any registered classes will not be paid for by the VA without certification.
- Submit a copy of your DD214-Member4 or NOBE.
- Submit a completed VA Entrance Counseling form.
- Complete and submit the <u>Enrollment Agreement and Acceptance of Responsibilities</u>.
- Meet with your advisor to develop a plan towards graduation and register for classes during a designated orientation day or a scheduled meeting.
  - o In order for the VA to pay for classes, designate a program of study which will lead to an Associate of Arts, Science, or Applied Science degree or eligible certificate listed in the DSCC catalog.

### TRANSFER STUDENTS ONLY

- Fill out and submit the Request for Change of Program or Place of Training (VA Form 22-1995).
- CHAPTERS 30, 33, 1606, 1607, and VRAP ONLY
  - You must call verify enrollment on or after the last day of each month to confirm you are still attending classes.
