Instruction Sheet for Nursing Admission Test

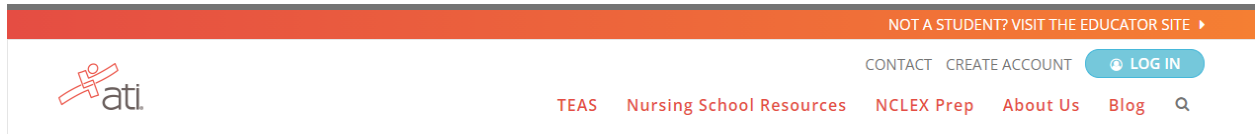
The Department of Nursing admissions exam is the Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS). Please follow the directions below to create an account, register and pay for the exam on the ATI website. Applicants will no longer pay DSCC for the admissions exam. The TEAS will be proctored by the DSCC Testing Department (731-286-3355).

TEAS can be taken as many times as needed with the highest grade being used. There is a required six month wait period between retesting. TEAS scores are good for three (3) years. If the TEAS is taken elsewhere, it is the responsibility of the applicant to submit a copy of his/her score that reflects the four sub-scores to the Department of Nursing.

When accessing ATI for registration, if Dyersburg State Community College does not appear as a location option, no test dates are currently available. Check back at a later date.

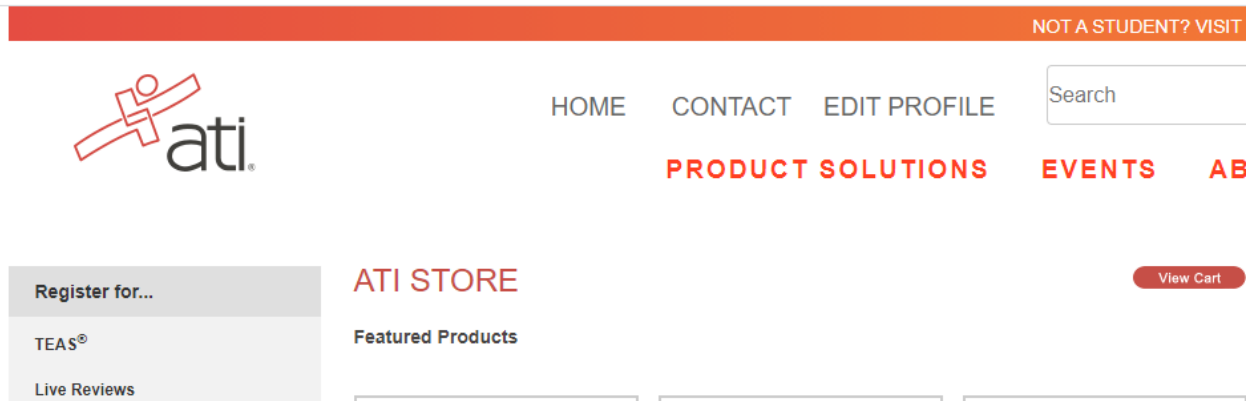
1. Go to www.atitesting.com.
2. Create a student account.



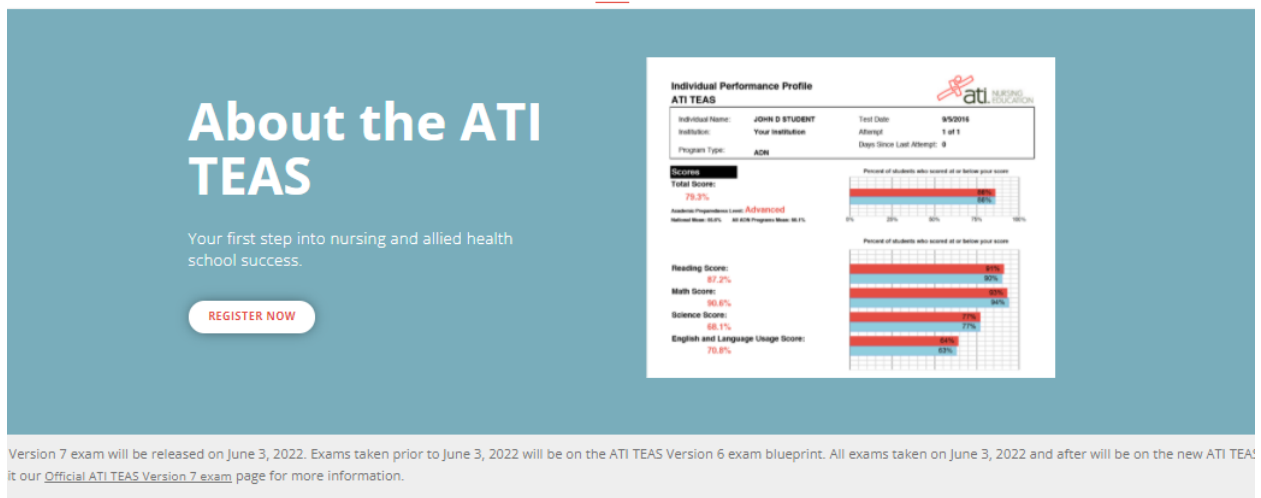
3. On the next page, complete the steps to create a new account.

6. On the following page, About the TEAS, select In-Person Proctored at an Institution. Click visit this page.

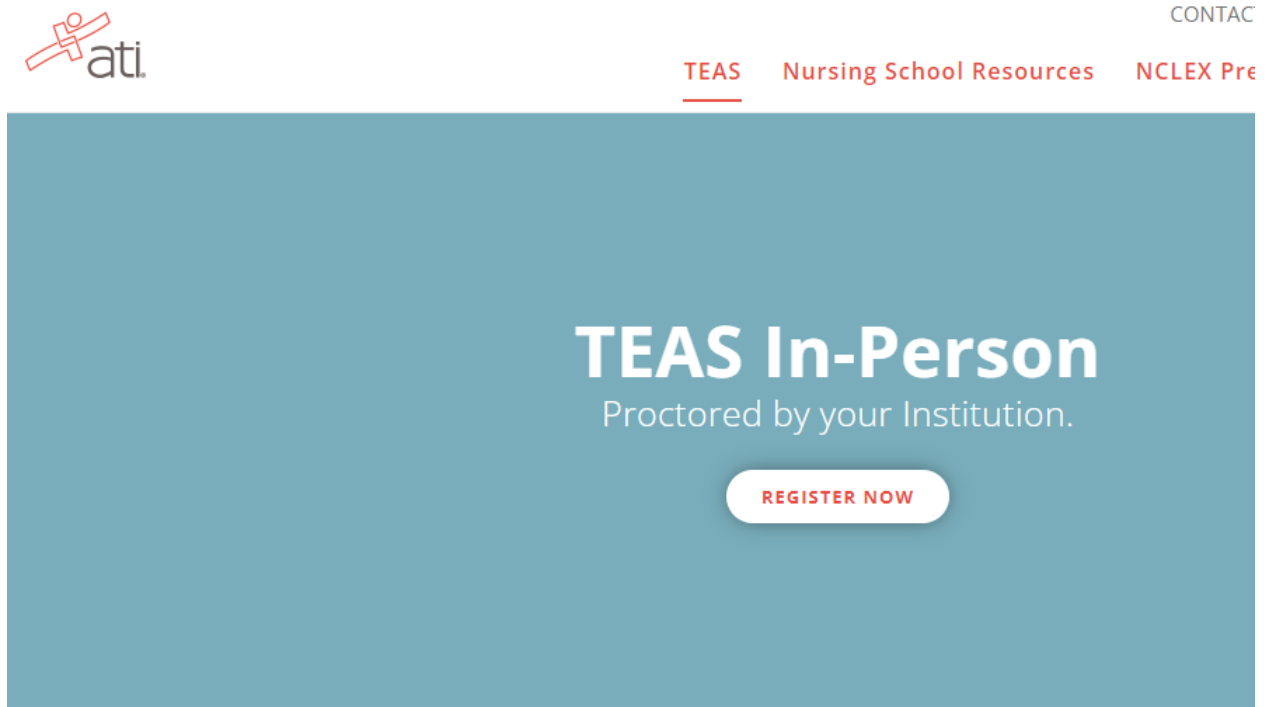


A step-by-step guide to registering for the TEAS
