TEAS TESTING GUIDELINES

Please Read Carefully!

- 1) The TEAS Exam for admission into the DSCC Nursing Program **must** be taken prior to the application deadline. If the exam is taken at a location other than DSCC, it is the responsibility of the applicant to attach a copy of the exam score to the nursing application.*
- 2) Applicants must wait six (6) months between testing dates. If applicants test prior to the six-month policy, the previous score will be used. DSCC Nursing and Testing Department are not responsible for cost associated with rescheduling test dates.
- 3) TEAS exam scores are good for three years from the application deadline.
- 4) DSCC Nursing will average the math and reading scores from the TEAS exam to obtain the applicant's test average. Although all portions of the test must be taken, only math and reading will be used for scoring purposes.
- 5) Applicants must follow the directions listed in the TEAS Testing Information link to schedule and pay for the exam. If DSCC is not listed as a testing location option, test dates have not been posted and applicants will need to check back at a later date.
- 6) Applicants should bring the username and password used to schedule the TEAS exam with them on test day. This same username and password will be used to log into the TEAS exam.
- 7) TEAS test dates will be posted throughout the year by the Testing Department. These dates will be posted in a timely manner to accommodate each of the application deadlines. If DSCC does not appear as a choice, no dates are available at that time. You will need to check back at a later date.
- 8) Do not wait to schedule your TEAS exam. Dates fill quickly and there will be no additional dates added and no scores taken if tested after the deadline.

** If testing from home, the applicant is responsible for attaching the correct report to the application at the time the application is completed. See notes below to ensure that the correct report is submitted with the application.*

When logged into your ATI Student account, click on the Results tab at the top to get a copy of your score report.

On the next screen, you will see your score results for your testing attempt and any previous testing attempts. To print out the score report needed for your Nursing application, click on the link - **ATI TEAS Version 7**. This link should be right above where you see your average for the 4 sections of the test. When you click on this link, it should pull up a score report like the one shown below.
