Program Completion

Traditional Program: Forty-five percent of all students who begin in the first NRSG course in the traditional program option will complete the AAS in four academic semesters.

Bridge Program: Forty-five percent of all students who begin in the first NRSG course in the bridge program option will complete the AAS in three academic semesters.

All Programs: Sixty Percent (60%) of students will complete the program within 150 percent of the program length.
