IDA MAE THEUS-MAYS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Ida Mae Theus-Mays Memorial Scholarship. Bishop J. Denard Williams, a DSCC graduate and pastor of Faith Deliverance Apostolic Church, Dyersburg, TN, Mrs. Emma Mays-Reynolds, DSCC Faculty Emeritus, Ms. Devalyn L. Reynolds, Associate Professor of Mathematics, the Mays' family, and the Faith Deliverance Apostolic Church members have established a scholarship in memory of a devout believer and supporter of education and the founder of Faith Deliverance Apostolic Church, Ida Mae Theus-Mays.

This scholarship is awarded to a second-year, full-time student at DSCC. Preferably, but never limited to, the student should be African-American, have and maintain a minimum 2.5 grade point average, be active in campus life at DSCC, and be an active member of a Christian-centered church. The following must accompany the completed application: 1) a letter from the applicant; 2) a reference/recommendation letter from church pastor; 3) a letter of reference/recommendation from a community leader.

Applicants seeking this scholarship should follow the directions for submittal to the Financial Aid Office at Dyersburg State Community College. The Trustees of Faith Deliverance Apostolic Church will make the selection. The scholarship description is also located on line and **in the Dyersburg State Community College Catalog and Student Handbook**.
